Prepurchase Clinical and Moving Examination: \$550.00

The clinical examination begins with a comprehensive evaluation of the horse's respiratory, cardiovascular, musculoskeletal and gastrointestinal systems. During the moving evaluation, the horse will be examined at a walk and trot on a firm surface, and lunged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions on a lunge line. A neurological exam will also be performed. In addition, flexions of the forelimbs and hind limbs will be evaluated. Under the direction of the veterinarian, the horse may be observed under saddle; therefore, we recommend bringing tack to the prepurchase examination.

Following the moving examination, the horse will proceed to a radiographic examination. It is standard in our comprehensive pre-purchase examination, to remove the horse's front shoes in order to obtain the best quality radiographs of the front feet. Exceptions will need to be discussed with the veterinarian performing the examination. Arrangements to have the shoes replaced are not responsibility of ECEVS. More advanced diagnostics such as ultrasound may be indicated if swelling, thickening, or sensitivity of the tendons or ligaments is palpated. A standard set of pre-purchase radiographs requires 24-32 views including: front feet/ navicular, all four fetlocks, both hocks and carpus, and both stifles. Digital radiographs can be provided upon request on a USB for a fee. All shipping charges will be at the buyer's expense.

**If a full set of radiographs accompany the horse and will be used instead of radiographs performed by our clinic, there will be a \$300 radiographic consultation fee.

(date). The scope of the examination and the selection of diagnostic tests chosen shall be determined by the buyer in consultation with ECEVS. The veterinarian whom conducts the pre-purchase examination will provide you with information regarding any existing medical problems and the horses overall health and condition of the given day of the examination. The examination is not intended to be used as a prognosis for future health, soundness or a warranty for the horse's suitability for any particular future use or purpose. The veterinarian's job is neither to pass nor fail the animal being examined. The determination by buyer to purchase the animal examined is solely buyer's choice and responsibility. The buyer should be aware that this examination does not encompass an in depth evaluation of the horse's temperament, ability, or aptitude for a particular discipline. It describes the horse's health and soundness on the day of examination. A routine pre-purchase examination may not reveal subtle unsoundness, especially if the horse has not been in hard/consistent work in the preceding months. Some conditions, such as mild recurrent airway obstruction ("heaves"), mild vision impairment, early PPID ("Cushing's Disease"), digestive disorders predisposing to colic signs, and muscle disorders such as equine polysaccharide storage myopathy ("tying up") may not be apparent during an examination. Buyer acknowledges that a material condition of ECVES' agreement to perform this pre-purchase examination is buyer's agreement to release, waive and discharge ECEVS, its veterinarians and employees from all claims arising directly or indirectly from the performance of the pre-purchase examination; this is a promise by buyer not to sue.
